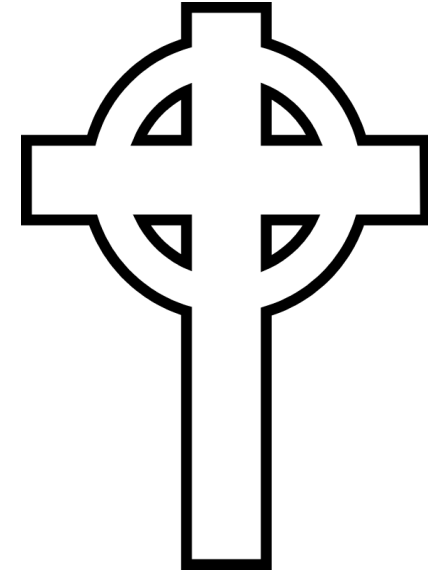

Q. 74. What is adoption?
